2018 is the Year of the Dog in the Chinese zodiac, believed since ancient time to be a year of sincerity and jollity, when evil is kept at bay and good fortune is brought to people. In addition to new zodiac dolls, on display and sale in this exhibition are a range of other fortune-bringing dolls for display at New Year.

Joint Exhibition - Hakata Magemono Maker TAMAKI and Hakata Doll Maker SHIMEKICHI (First day from 12 pm, final day until 4 pm)

Bent-wood craft and Hakata dolls
(Nationally Designated Traditional Craft)

Hakata Magemono are containers made by bending thin wooden boards and binding the end of the boards together with cherry tree bark. In addition to traditional containers for rice and multi-tiered food boxes, on display and sale in this exhibition is a lineup of more contemporary works including CD cases and wine buckets. The Hakata dolls presented here feature clothing with elaborate depictions of beautiful flowers.
