Japanese Washi Paper, Light and Tombodama Glass Beads Exhibition

Japanese handmade paper, etc

An exhibition of works by an artisan who creates openwork Japanese washi paper made from wood fibers, as well as hand-dyed washi paper. On display and sale are Japanese paper tapestries containing dried flowers, decorative folding screens, lampshades made with cherry tree bark, and colored glass accessories.

A wide range of items are on display and sale, with works by seasoned artists and apprentices, as well as Chinese zodiac dolls for next year.
